MCA Bookstore at Quantico Hosts Author Colonel Wes Fox at Book Signing Event

Marine Corps Base Quantico, Virginia – The Marine Corps Association will host a book signing by Colonel Wesley L. Fox, USMC (Ret), Medal of Honor recipient and author of *Marine Rifleman: Forty-Three Years in the Corps* and *Courage and Fear: A Primer*.

Marine Rifleman is the story of Marine Corps legend and Medal of Honor recipient Colonel Wes Fox.
