

Ammunition Technician of the Year

Cpl Conner N. Allam

Corporal Conner N. Allam was born on 25 February 2003 in East China, Michigan. He enlisted in the Marine Corps as an Ammunition Technician Specialist and graduated from 2nd Recruit Training Battalion, Parris Island, South Carolina in September of 2021. Following Recruit Training, he completed Marine Combat Training at School of Infantry East, Camp Geiger, North Carolina.

In October 2021, Corporal Conner Allam attended Recruiters Assistance in R.S.S Macomb, Richmond, Michigan. Then in November 2021 he attended Ammunition Technician Specialist schooling at Marine Corps Detachment Bravo Company, Ft. Lee, Virginia. During his schooling he was Meritoriously Promoted to Lance Corporal in December 2021. Upon graduation in January 2022 he was awarded Distinguished Honor Graduate and received a Certificate of Commendation. After graduation he received orders to 3d Sustainment Group (Experimental), Ammunition Company, Camp Schwab, Okinawa, Japan.

In March 2022, Corporal Allam obtained his Grey belt in the Marine Corps Martial Arts Program. Then following in April 2022, he attended the 3d Sustainment Group (Experimental) MCREE as well as completed Lance Corporal Leadership and Ethics Seminar with 3d Sustainment Group (Experimental), Camp Kinser, Okinawa where he was awarded a Meritorious Mast for being Honor Graduate. During his tenure at Lance Corporal Leadership and Ethics Seminar he also obtained his Green Belt in the Marine Corps Martial Arts Program.

In May 2022, Corporal Allam obtained the Team Leader billet while serving in Storage Platoon. In July 2022, he was responsible for a resupply to the Henoko Ammunition Supply Point which included, over 26 Line Items spanning between 23 containers and costing \$35.5 million, he was also nominated for a Marine of the Quarter board. In August 2022 he attended the Henoko Field Ammunition Supply Point as well as obtained his 1.5 ton government license. In September 2022 he was also entrusted with the preparation and overseas shipment of ammunition for KAMANDANG Exercise 2022 which included 180 productivity hours to complete as well as 68 line items spanning 8 containers where he worked hand and hand with the 31st Marine Expeditionary Unit. In October 2022 he was awarded another Meritorious Mast for his support on KAMANDANG Exercise 2022.

In October 2022 he was nominated for his second Marine of the Quarter Board. In November 2022 Corporal Allam attended the Fire Warden Course to further his expertise in fire safety, as well as fire extinguisher inspection. During this time, he obtained his Fork Lift License as well as, aided in the preparation of overseas shipment for Disposition Ammunition to Sasebo, Japan and exercise Marine Rotational Force- Darwin 2022 ammunition to Australia.

In December 2022, Corporal Allam was meritoriously promoted to Corporal. Later in January 2023, Corporal Allam was attached to 3d Maintenance Battalion in support of Korean Marine Exchange Program (KMEP) 23.1. He was then attached back to 3d Sustainment Group (Experimental) in support of KMEP 23.2. February 2023, Corporal Allam was awarded Ammunition Technician of the Year. Upon returning to Ammunition Company, Okinawa, he further supported Pier Operations for the turn-in of Balikpapan 23 ammunition in May 2023.

Currently Corporal Allam serves as a Team Leader in the Henoko Ammunition Supply Point under Ammunition Company, 3d Sustainment Group (Experimental), where he is entrusted with leading 17 Marine as their posing Section Head as well as to keep account for their personal safety and the accountability of 40 keys, multiple radios and government vehicles.
