Mr. Justin Bogue

Mr. Justin Bogue is a native of Newcastle, Wyoming. He graduated from South Dakota School of Mines and Technology in 1996 with a B.S. in Interdisciplinary Science. He was commissioned as an infantry officer in the US Army in 1996 and attended Infantry Officer Captains Career Course, Information Operations (IO) Qualification Course, Intermediate Level Education (CGSC Satellite Course), Joint Information Operations Planners Course, Special Technical Operations (STO) Planners Course, and Military Deception Planners Course. He is also a Graduate of US Army Ranger School, Pathfinder School, Airborne School, Air Assault School and the Bradley Leaders Course.

Mr. Bogue's military service includes serving as Platoon Leader of an Infantry Platoon, Specialty Platoon Leader, Company Executive Officer, and Company Commander of Mechanized Infantry Company and Basic Combat Training Company. Operationally he served as an embedded training team leader in Nuristan Province Afghanistan, BDE Information Operations Officer in Eastern Afghanistan and ISAF Joint Command Key Leader Engagements Chief. Additional military assignments include Observer Controller/Trainer conducting post mobilization training of US Army National Guard and Reserve Units deploying to Iraq and Afghanistan, US Army Europe STO/IO planner and was a member of the US Army Forces Command Commanders Initiative Group.

After retirement he served as a contractor in Afghanistan working as a Special Activities planner and Information Operations planner. In November of 2019 Mr. Bogue began working at US Marine Forces, Pacific as the deputy G39 director for the G6/G39 division. In this position Mr. Bogue works supervises a team of 18 Marines, Civilians, and contractors fulfilling roles in all information capabilities.
