CM1(SCW/EXW/AW) Sean A. LaCue reported to MCAS Iwakuni, Japan, in April 2024, where he is serving as the Headquarters and Headquarters Squadron Motor Transportation Division Maintenance Chief.

CM1 LaCue enlisted in the United States Navy in September 2011 and attended Basic Training in Great Lakes, Illinois. After graduating, he attended Aviation Electrician's Mate "A" School in Pensacola, Florida.

He reported to Helicopter Sea Combat Squadron SIX (HSC-6) at NAS North Island, where he deployed on the USS NIMITZ (CVN-68) for the CVW-17 WestPac deployment in 2013, serving as Line Division Night Shift Supervisor, Plane Captain, and Landing Signalman. While at HSC-6, CM1 served as a Quality Assurance Representative (QAR), Avionics Department Assistant Leading Petty Officer (ALPO), and Departmental Collateral Duty Quality Assurance Representative (CDQAR), advancing to Second Class Petty Officer during his assignment.

In 2016, he cross-rated to the Seabees and attended Construction Mechanic "A" School in Port Hueneme, California. CM1 then reported to Naval Mobile Construction Battalion THREE (NMCB-3) from 2017 to 2024, deploying five times to various locations, including Okinawa, Japan; the Republic of Palau; Papua New Guinea; and Guam. While assigned to NMCB-3, he served as Alfa Company Work Center Supervisor, Alfa Company Preventive Maintenance Shop Supervisor, and NMCB-3 Command Fitness Leader.

CM1 LaCue is authorized to wear the following distinctions and awards: Enlisted Seabee Combat Warfare (SCW), Expeditionary Warfare (EXW), Enlisted Aviation Warfare Specialist (EAWS), Navy and Marine Corps Achievement Medal (3rd award), Battle "E" (5th award), Good Conduct Medal (4th award), Navy Meritorious Unit Commendation, National Defense Service Medal, Global War on Terrorism Service Medal, Global War on Terrorism Expeditionary Medal, Sea Service Deployment Ribbon (6th award), and Overseas Service Ribbon.
