

There are two options to gain access to Quantico to attend the event:

OPTION 1: Go to the Visitors Center before 3 pm and within 14 days of the event. You will need to:

1. Pre-enroll in DBIDS at the following link: [DBIDS \(dmdc.mil\)](https://dmdc.mil)
2. Print off the DBIDS registration confirmation
3. Complete and print out [NAVMC 5512](#) form.
4. Ensure you bring at least **two** of the following documents:
 - United States Passport
 - Permanent Resident Card/Alien Registration Receipt Card (Form I-551)
 - Foreign Passport with a temporary (I-551) stamp or temporary (I-551) printed notation on a machine-readable immigrant visa
 - An employment authorization document that contains a photograph (Form I-766)
 - Current/Valid Driver's License (cannot say "Federal Limits Apply" or "Not for Federal use")
 - Identification card issued by Federal, State or local Government Agencies (IE Social Security Card)
 - U.S. Coast Guard Merchant Mariner Legacy Cards
 - U.S. Coast Guard New Merchant Mariner Credential
 - Approved Department of Defense (DoD) Privilege Card Holder
5. Bring your **DBIDS registration confirmation**, completed **NAVMC 5512**, and **two forms of ID** to the Marine Corps Base Quantico Visitor Control Center.

Option 2:

On the day of the event, go to the front gate of the base off of Fuller Road and expect to be pulled over like it's a traffic stop. Tell the guard that you (and anyone else riding with you) are on the list to attend the Marine Corps Association Dinner that evening at The Clubs at Quantico. At that time a guard will review your materials – be sure to have all of the information listed in OPTION 1 with you (and any guests who may be traveling with you). They may also ask for your **insurance information** – so be sure you have your most up to date insurance cards with you.
