Sergeant Menani was born in Niles, MI on 19 January 2000. He graduated from Andrews Academy, Berrien Springs, MI (2018) and departed for MCRD Parris Island, S.C., in July of 2019. Sergeant Menani graduated Boot Camp in September 2019.
